### **UMS Martial Arts Sick Policy**

- 1. If your child will not attend UMS Martial Arts After School Program for any reason, especially due to illness, please call us and leave a message or e-mail us <a href="mailto:umsmartialarts@gmail.com">umsmartialarts@gmail.com</a> as soon as possible. Daily attendance is taken and we do need to know if your child will not be in attendance.
- 2. Unless otherwise instructed by a Healthcare provided, children running a fever of 100'F or greater should remain at home for at least 24 hours after the fever has broken.
- 3. Unless otherwise instructed by a healthcare provider, children with recurrent vomiting or diarrhea should remain at home for at least 24 hours after vomiting or diarrhea has stopped.
- 4. If your child has a communicable disease, the parents are required to notify UMS Martial Arts so that the parents of the other children may be notified
- 5. Children who have had a communicable disease may not return to the program, unless they have a doctor's note stating that they are not longer contagious
- 6. Children will have a daily health check when they arrive at the program. If the staff feels that the child is not well or has a fever of 100 degrees or higher, parents will be called and asked to pick their child up. You must make arrangements to pick up your child as soon as possible.

### **UMS Martial Arts Behavior Agreement**

We want every day at UMS Martial Arts to be a happy memory for your children. Therefore, we work hard at creating an environment that will allow this to happen. Along with our efforts, we need the children to help us create that environment by following some simple, but effective rules. Below is our Behavior Agreement. Please read over it with your child/children and make sure they understand what it is, and why they are signing it. This will help them have a wonderful experience during the UMS Martial Arts After School Program.

UMS Martial Arts Basic Rule: 1. Safety First 2. Respect People 3. Respect Property

- I will listen to the staff and follow their directions.
- I will respect other people's belongings by not touching or using their belongings without their permission.
- I will respect other's personal space by keeping my hands and feet to myself.
- I will not hit or fight other people
- I will use appropriate language, which does not include any swear words or negative remarks.
- Before leaving the room, I will ask a staff member present for permission.
- I will respect other's feelings by having a positive attitude when talking to them and not talking down to others.
- Children must wear their seat belts at all times when being transported by UMS Martial Arts. We will
  give only one warning. If they still do not wear their seat belts, they will be suspended from riding the
  UMS Martial Arts vans.

We explain these rules to the children the first day and throughout their time at the After School program. Not abiding by these rules can result in suspension from the program. All incidents will be handled on a 5 strike incident system, except hitting/fighting. <u>Hitting/fighting will be an immediate 1-day suspension from the program. All other incidents will be handled as follows</u>:

1 <sup>st</sup> Incident:	VERBAL WARNING
2 <sup>nd</sup> Incident:	Time out 4minutes or Push ups/Squat Jumps (10 – 30 times)
3 <sup>rd</sup> Incident:	WRITTEN WARNING/PARENT MEETING
4 <sup>th</sup> Incident:	1-DAY SUSPENSION
5 <sup>th</sup> Incident:	PERMANANT SUSPENSION

HB 1905 amended the exemption from licensure under code of Virginia 63.2-1715-2, commonly referred to as "come and go". The following child day programs shall not be required to be licensed:

2. A Program where, by written policy given to and signed by a parent or guardian, school-aged children are free to enter and leave the premises without permission or supervision, regardless of (i) such program's location or the number of days per week of its operation; (ii)the provision of transportation services, including drop-off and pick up times; or (iii) the scheduling of breaks and snacks, homework, or other activities. A program that would qualify for this exemption except that it assumes responsibility for the supervision, protection and well-being of several children with disabilities who are mainstreamed shall not be subject to licensure.

- 1. In case schools are closed due to bad weather, here are the standard procedures:
  - If both the federal government and county schools are closed due to bad weather, then UMS will closed. (NO day camp or regular class)
  - o If Federal Government opens with a 2 hour delay, then UMS will have day camp open 9:30am –6:30pm
